The cumulative grade point average (GPA) is calculated based on semester grades in all courses in grades 9-12, using a 4.3 scale.


- Due to an exceptional level of difficulty, semester grades for Honors (H) courses receive an extra semester GPA weight of 0.5.

Since 2021, SACS has had 6 National Merit Finalists, 1 National Merit Semi-Finalist, and 10 National Merit Commended Scholars.




THE CURRICULUM
