The cumulative grade point average (GPA) is calculated based on semester grades in all courses in grades 9-12, using a 4.3 scale.

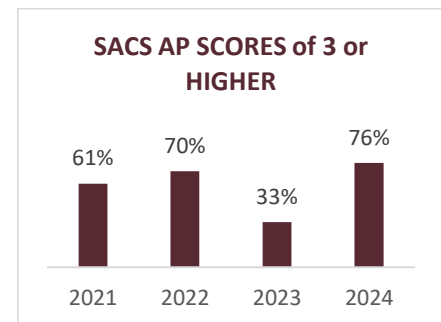
- Due to an exceptional level of difficulty, semester grades for Honors (H) courses receive an extra semester GPA weight of 0.5.
- Advanced Placement/Dual Credit (AP/DC) courses receive an extra semester GPA weight of 1.0.

Since 2021, SACS has had 6 National Merit Finalists, 1 National Merit Semi-Finalist, and 10 National Merit Commended Scholars.



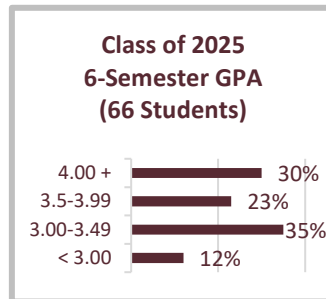
THE CURRICULUM

Since approximately 98% of SACS graduates attend four-year colleges upon graduation, emphasis is placed not only on teaching content, but also on developing lifelong learners who are adept at reading, writing, and critical reasoning. Students receive daily enrichment classes to explore subjects and activities beyond the primary curriculum fostering intellectual, creative, and personal growth.
